All Parks and Recreation Department programs operate on a self-supporting basis, which limits the amount of available aid that we can provide. Financial assistance is only available for programs that are run directly by Parks and Recreation Department staff.

Financial assistance is not available for programs where we hire an outside vendor to run the program. Assistance is for residents of the City of Peabody or children who are attending any Peabody public school.

Note: All children who receive free school lunch are entitled to one free week and a reduced rate for any remaining sessions of the Playground Program and those who receive reduced lunch are entitled to a reduced rate for all sessions of the Playground Program without the need to apply for any scholarship.
